Preschool (3 & 4 years of age)

This program teaches skating skills through the use of simple instruction, games and toys. The goal is to help skaters develop balance and coordination on ice, with the emphasis on having fun in a group format.

This National CanSkate Badge Program teaches beginner & up skating skills in 6 stages. 15 min. warm up & then half hour group format lesson all exclusively taught by our NCCP Certified Professional Coaches.

CSA approved Hockey/Skating helmets are mandatory.
Bike/Ski helmets are not permitted.

Private lessons are optional. Average 8:1 Ratio

CanSkate badges 5 – 7 taught incl. an introduction to figure skating. 15 min. warm up, 30 min. group lessons, 15 min. supervised practice time. Skaters must have completed a minimum of Stage 4 CanSkate to qualify. Skating helmets mandatory. Private lessons optional.

STAR Skate PROGRAMS

Novice

Program focuses on skating techniques that will prepare skaters for competitions and tests evaluated by Skate Canada certified judges. Skaters develop their Dance, Skating Skills, Freeskate and Stroking techniques in **private lesson format**. A 15 minute group Stroking lesson is provided per session.

Skaters must have passed CanSkate Level 7 to be eligible for this program.

Private lessons optional.* CSA approved hockey/skating helmets are mandatory in order to participate in this class.

For Parents and Skaters

Membership in the Richmond Hill Skating Club is a privilege and will be revoked for inappropriate behavior on the part of parents or skaters. Membership is not transferable to another person.

Payment in full by personal cheque, credit card or cash is required at the time of registration. Cost for each returned cheque will be borne by the author of the cheque - \$25.00.

Absolutely no refunds after opening day of the season. An administration fee of \$25.00 will be held back on refunds issued prior to opening day of the season, following receipt of a written request for withdrawal **prior** to season start date.

Annual Skate Canada fee is non-refundable.

Fees will not be prorated for late registration.

Skaters may only skate on the days for which they have registered.

No allowance or "make ups" will be made for a skater who misses any class, OR classes cancelled due to Club Competition Day and/or Test Days OR classes cancelled due to closure(s) due to severe weather, unforeseen arena circumstances, etc.

Skaters making a change to their schedule, after the start of the program, will be subject to a \$10.00 administration fee.

The Club reserves the right to limit the number of skaters in each session and to cancel or re-schedule any session due to low enrolment.

Skaters under the age of 12 must have a Parent or Guardian in the arena at all times during sessions.
